DIET TRIAL


A diet trial is the gold-standard for determining a pet's food sensitivities. Our food test results allow you to have a starting point for that diet trial.

NEXTMUNE'S TESTING

There are 2 categories of results on a food test from Nextmune: either the patient is positive or negative. However, the results must be sub-categorized one step further, in order to know how to treat the patient.

INTERPRETING RESULTS

Since exposure plays a role in IgE elevations, you should also categorize foods into known exposure and unknown exposure. Once you have the exposure category, then you know how to prioritize the ingredients. Our food lists treat all positives as requiring removal. However, it is important to understand that a negative without exposure may become a positive with regular exposure. Therefore, a food sensitivity test should only be considered a starting point for a diet trial, not a full indicator of the animal's total sensitivities.



Why allergy treatment?

Allergy testing without proceeding to allergy therapy does little to improve your dog's quality of life. Allergy therapy is the ONLY way to increase tolerance and address the root cause of their symptoms without harsh side effects. How long will they last? Injections last 283 days and the oral drops last 100 days. Injections start out every other day and work up to once per month, whereas drops are once daily. They both can treat up to 20 allergens in a single set.

When should I see improvement?



ANNUAL e a non-smok

Smoking	Make your home a non-smoking environment.	
Home Foundation	Check for gaps, cracks, and leaks. Address with a waterproofing seal.	
Carpet	Replace with wood, tile, or linoleum. Have carpets professionally cleaned to sanitize and remove allergens.	
Extermination	Have your home serviced by professional exterminators.	
Air Ducts	Have air ducts professionally cleaned.	
Mold Inspection	Inspect the interior and exterior of your home for visible mold growth. If necessary, consult a professional mold removal service.	
	SEMI-ANNUAL	
Windows & Doors	Check and seal all gaps and leaks. Ensure screens are properly installed. Keep windows closed on windy or humid days.	
Insulation	Check for worn insulation; replace if necessary.	
Plumbing	Maintain all faucets, pipes, and bathtubs. Inspect for leaks and seal them immediately.	
Home Exterior	Treat foundation with fungicidal spray.	
Bedding	Clean mattress thoroughly. If possible, encase with allergy cover.	
Laundry Room	Inspect washer and dryer connections for leaks. Ensure that dryer is venting to the outside.

Air Filters	Inspect air conditioning and heating filters for cleanliness and to ensure proper installation. Check filters on air purifier units.	
Landscape	Prune tree and shrub branches away from the home to prevent mold growth.	
Hyposensitization	Be sure to give your dog their allergy treatment.	

CHECKLIST:

ALLERGY-PROOFING YOUR HOME

WEEKLY

Dust Control	Use a static cloth or dust spray. Allow dust to settle for 20 minutes before vacuuming. Store items that gather dust in sealed boxes or display items in glass cases.
Vacuum	Thoroughly vacuum. Use a vacuum with a filter size of 5 microns or smaller to trap dust mites, mold spores, and pollen. Change filter frequently and never reuse filters.
Dehumidifier Maintenance	Clean filter and collection chamber with 10% bleach solution.
Laundry	Wash all bedding and stuffed toys in hot water. If available, run exhaust fan while laundering. Place washed items in hot dryer, never line-dry outside. Store washed materials immediately to avoid dust contamination.
Landscape	Avoid mowing lawns during the peak pollen production times of the early morning and evening.
Garbage	Have garbage removed weekly. Wash all garbage collection containers and spray with insecticide.
Bathroom & Kitchen	Clean visible mold with 10% bleach solution.
Dog	Bathe your dog regularly to remove dust and pollens.
	DAILY
Bathroom & Kitchen	Run exhaust fans while showering and cooking to reduce humidity. Remove all garbage and trash daily.
Dehumidifier Maintenance	Remove water from collection chamber.
Dog	Wash your dog's paws when returning from outside to remove dust and pollens.
