Nicole Frost Nyquist is an Associate Professor in animal nutrition at the Norwegian University of Life Sciences (NMBU), Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at Ås, Norway. She has her degree in veterinary medicine from Szent István University, Budapest, Hungary and her PhD in animal nutrition (focused on essential fatty acids and selenium in animal feed) from the Faculty of Biosciences at NMBU. Nicole is currently completing her resident period for The European College of Veterinary and Comparative Nutrition at the University Hospital for Companion Animal in Copenhagen. Nicole's professional life includes working as a veterinarian for companion animals, being veterinary responsible for an international dog food brand in Norway, R&D manager for pig feed at one of Norway's three feed companies, and working with feed supplements for dogs and cats.
